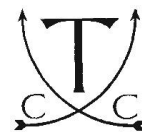
Pine needles are being spread among the pine trees and wood chips are being placed in plant beds along with needed edging. We are also spraying the course with preemergence chemicals to control the weeds and crabgrass. **Please**, fix any ball marks that you see on the greens. Your group can help make the greens the best in the area. We have also noticed the white band inside the hole being broken from golfers trying to remove the ball with the head of their putter. This causes the sides of the hole to be reamed out and damages the hole.

The # 14 lake has almost completely filled with all the rain that fell this winter. For some unknown reason, the break in the drain stopped leaking but this is only temporary. It could start leaking again at any moment. As soon as the ground dries out, plans are to permanently plug the drainpipe at the bottom of the dam. A new overflow pipe will be installed at the right corner of the lake near #6 green. It will be about the same level as the old overflow pipe. If the water gets high enough that the overflow pipe cannot carry the water, then the spillway on the left side of the lake comes into play.

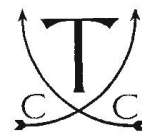

Today in History

From December 2020 to March 2021, 258 dead ash trees were removed from the course by the Greens staff. These trees had been planted 30 years ago. The trees that could be used for fire wood was split and sold for

approximately \$6,000, the proceeds of which was reinvested in maintenance equipment. The stumps were dug up and burned along with all the brush. The holes were then refilled with dirt. This was all done with a greens staff of four full time employees and the use of four to five college students during their winter break. It was quite a team effort in how it was organized and accomplished.
