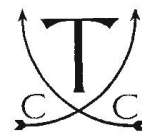

Pine needles are being spread among the pine trees and wood chips are being placed in plant beds along with needed edging. We are also spraying the course and driving range with preemergence chemicals to control the weeds and crabgrass. The winter cups on the greens were removed and replaced with new cups and flag sticks. All bushes and crape myrtles have been trimmed around the club house and entrance. River rock is also being placed along the entrance next to the new mulch.

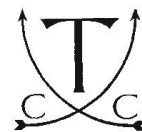

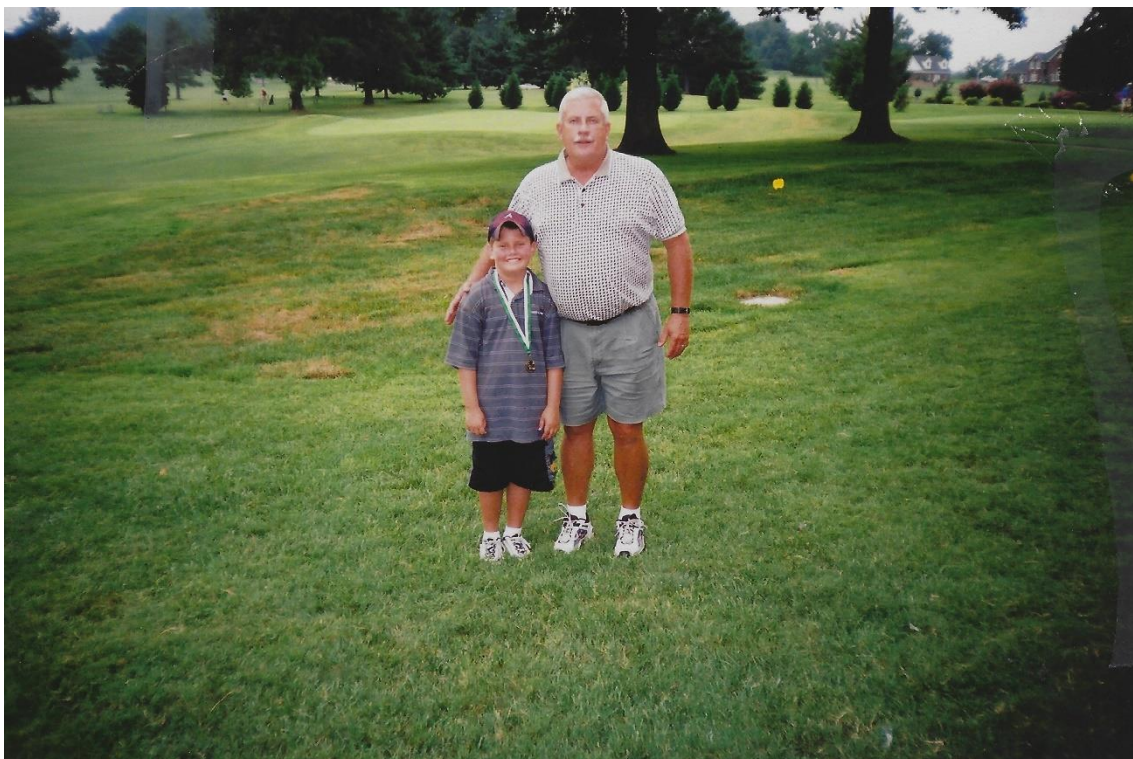
